ACCOMMODATION

Student accommodation at King Edward's is split into several boarding houses. Younger students on Bucky Kids (ages 7-10) are placed in Queen Mary House, whilst the slightly older students (ages 10-13) on the other courses are placed in Edward, Tudor and St Bridget's boarding houses on the other side of the school.

Bedrooms are made up of single, twin and 4-bed rooms, with separate female and male accommodation. Bathrooms are shared between 4-6 students.

Bucksmore offers a free airport transfer service for all students at King Edward's arriving and/or departing between 10:00-22:00 at:


- London Heathrow (LHR)

LAUNDRY

Laundry is available on site. Once per week, laundry will be collected by King Edward's School staff and returned the next day.





SPORTS FACILITIES

Students at King Edward's can take advantage of top-quality sporting facilities, including a sports hall, swimming pool, astroturf, multiple tennis courts, netball courts and grass playing fields.



STUDENT COMMON ROOMS

Each boarding house at King Edward's comes with a social space on the ground floor that students can use to relax and socialise in between lessons, activities and meals.



ACTIVITY SPACES

King Edward's has a variety of different activity spaces that can be used, including the 'Blue Room' (for discos), a dance studio, lecture theatre and 'Exhibition Hall' - a large hall used for the main evening activities.



QUEEN MARY HOUSE (BUCKY KIDS)

Exclusively used for the Bucky Kids programme, Queen Mary House is a wonderful self-contained house with bedrooms, social areas and activity space for the younger learners to use.
